## **OLAC Pre-Surgery Certification Checklist**



All surgeons **must** be certified by OLAC vet staff prior to performing surgery independently.

## Steps to Certification:

- 1) Certification in Anesthesia (This must be done separately from your surgery certification)
  References: Guidelines for Anesthesia and Analgesia in Laboratory Animals and
  Recordkeeping Guidelines for Surgical Procedures on Laboratory Animals
- 2) Certification in Euthanasia (Review Animal Disposition section of your AUP) References: <u>Euthanasia Guidelines</u> and <u>Guidelines for Humane Endpoints in Animal Studies</u>
- 3) Complete "Aseptic Technique & Recognizing Rodent Pain" https://olac.berkeley.edu/1/

- 4) Review the surgical procedure in the ACUC-approved AUP, including anesthetics and analgesics.
- 5) Obtain authorization for use of controlled substances:
  - EHS/how-do-i-get-authorization-use-controlled-substances-my-research
  - Anesthetics and analgesics: submit a <u>Pharmacy Purchase Request</u> if needed.
- 6) Practice a <u>terminal</u> surgical procedure in advance (animal is euthanized prior to recovering from anesthesia).
  - Submit a <u>Research Services Request</u> for isoflurane machine rental at least two (2) business days prior to your scheduled certification.
- 7) When you are prepared to perform your surgical technique, request certification at: OLAC Certifications, Training, & Breeding Info.

**Three** broad categories will be checked during the surgery process:

- 1) Are you following what your AUP describes?
- 2) Are you following proper aseptic surgical technique?
- 3) Does the animal recover and with no complications post-op? (survival procedure)
- 8) Vet staff will confirm the above and send you an email confirming certification.
  - Your PI is responsible for keeping a record of your training. (keep a copy in a folder)
